Student IDs

Every student received a student ID at the beginning of the school year. This 2 in 1 ID is required to be worn at school everyday by every student. These ID's will be used daily for checking out library books, purchasing school lunches and will also be used on field trips days. The IDs and lanyards will be kept at school each day. Bus riders received a 2nd ID that is attached to their backpack to badge on and off the bus.

Replacement ID's - If your child misplaces their ID or damages their ID, a request for a new ID needs to be submitted to the front office. Each replacement ID costs \$5

It is required that your child keep up with, and wear, their ID everyday. Student ID's are part of keeping your child safe at school.

Beginning of the Year PE information

Behavior Systems

Ranger Points (Clips) -In P.E., we use a Positive Behavior System where students can earn clips/points. These points are used to purchase items at our Texan Token store

Strikes

If a student is not following the rules:

- 1)Strike 1 :Student receives a verbal warning
- 2) Strike 2: Student is asked to go review the rules poster and tell a coach what rule they were not following, and how they will fix the behavior (i.e. move away from another student etc.)
- 3) Strike 3: Student is removed from the activity and asked to walk/ run /continue moving(student choice) around the perimeter of the gym. We do not use any sort of sitting “time-out” in the gym as this is counter productive to our goal of getting students moving . If we have to talk to a student about behavior 3 times in one class, I will typically send a note home so that parents are aware of what is happening.

Participation Policy- Participation in PE is so very important. State law mandates that students get a minimum of 135 minutes per week of moderate to vigorous Physical Activity. On top of that, we all know that students need to move more:) For these reasons we want all students participating in P.E. to the best of their ability. If students are injured and may not participate AT ALL I ask for a note from parents explaining how long the student will need to sit out. If your child will need to be out for more than a week, we ask that a Doctor's note be sent explaining what activities your child is prohibited from doing and for how long. If a student has a minor injury or needs to modify any activity for any reason, they have permission to do so at any time and **DO NOT NEED A NOTE:).**

PE Attire- Students have PE twice a week at JWE and will need to have the proper shoes and attire. Students should wear closed-toed shoes without a heel. If we feel the shoes a student is wearing are unsafe I will ask them to put on some of our “loaner” tennis shoes we have in the gym. Ideally we ask that they bring their own tennis shoes, but we have some for back up. Also, please have students wear shorts or pants under skirts/dresses please.

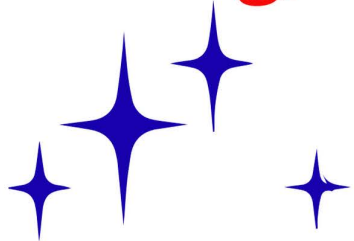
