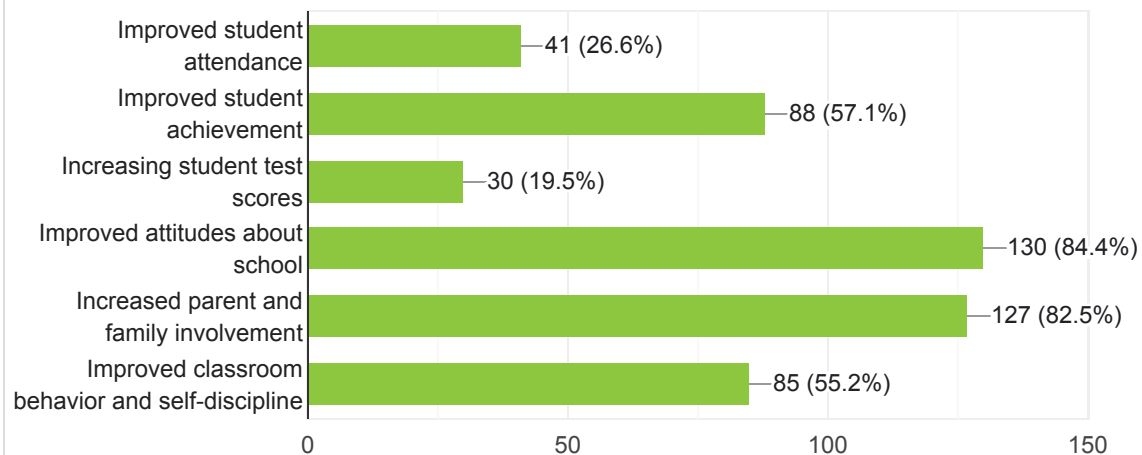

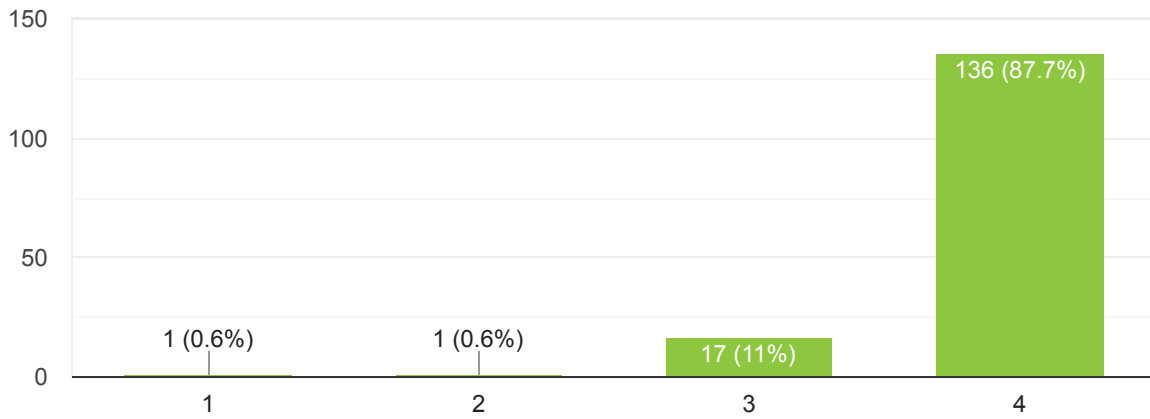

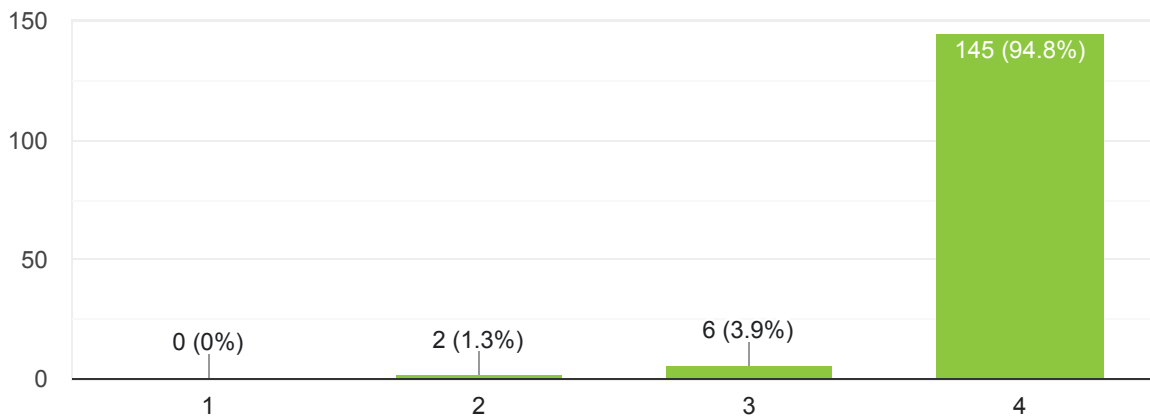

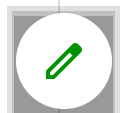

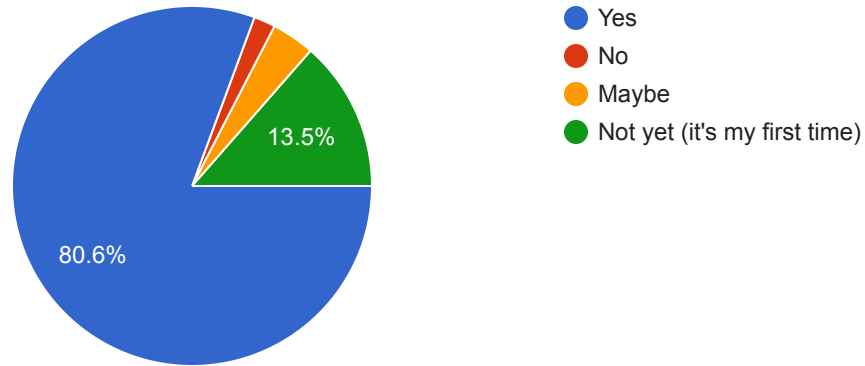

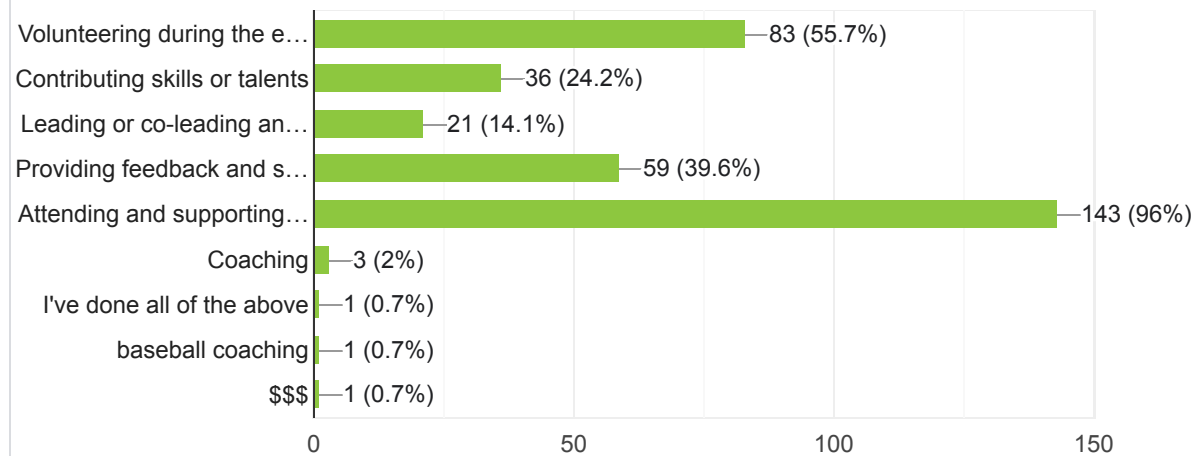

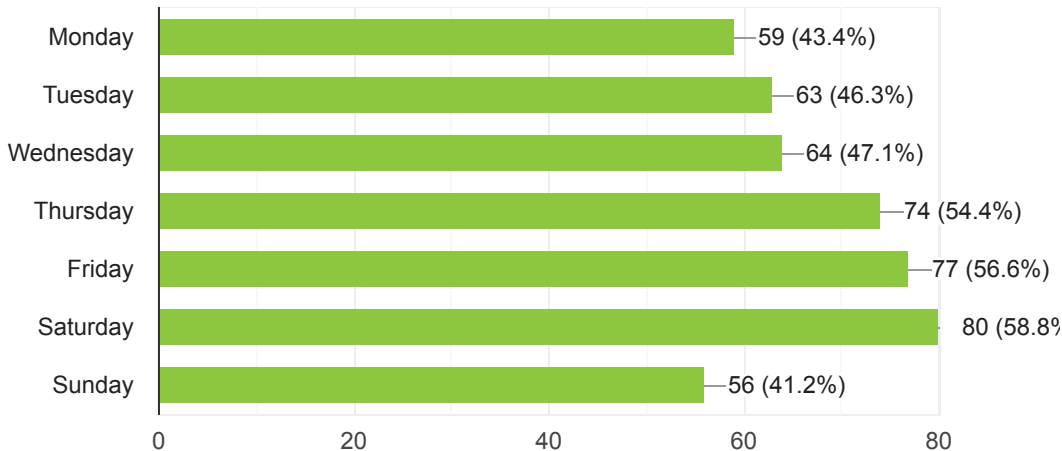

What day of the week works best for your family to attend school events?



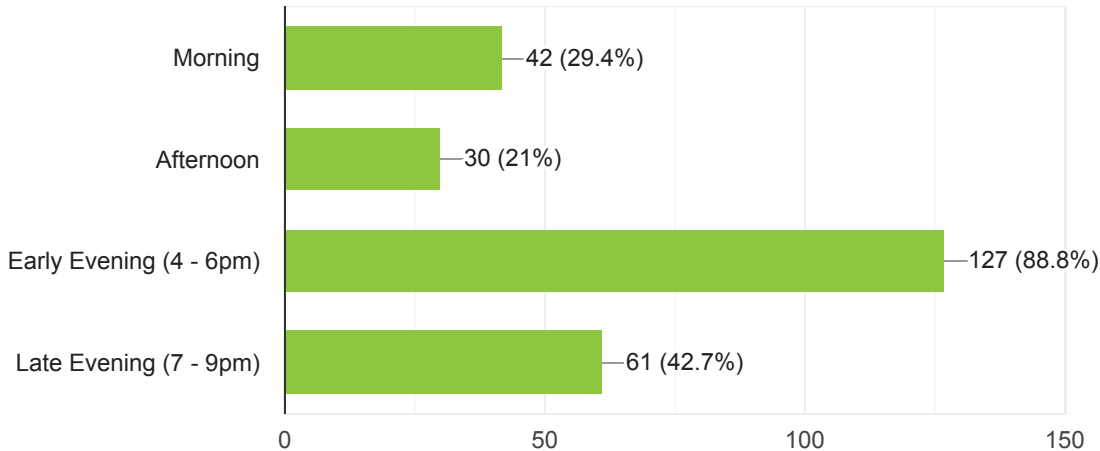

What time of day or day of the week works best for your family to attend school events?



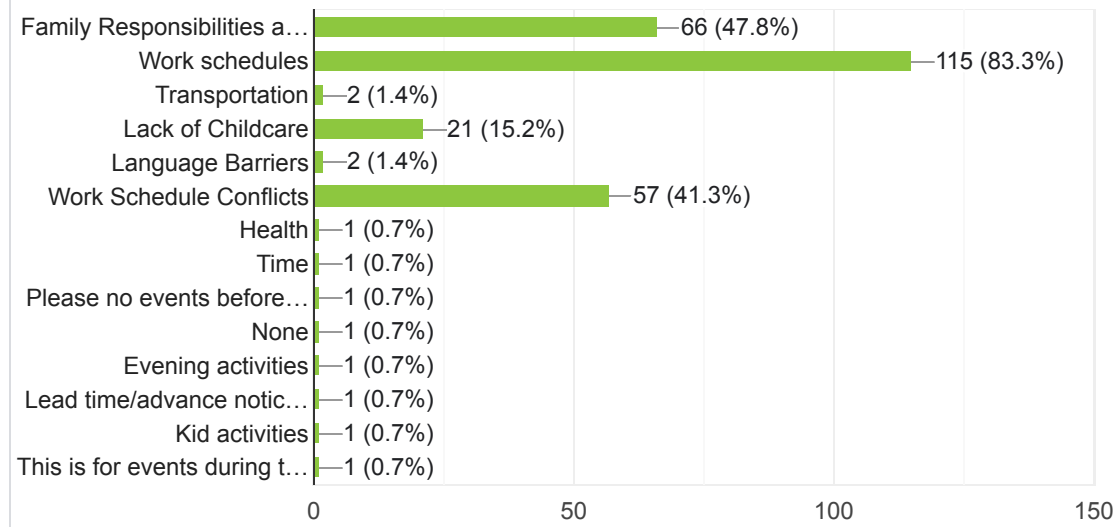
