

Proposed 2025 Bond

Building for the Future, Preserving Our Schools—**Without Raising Taxes**

Thompson School District is exploring a **\$99 million bond measure** for the 2025 ballot to address critical facility needs, enhance safety and security, and support future-ready learning environments—**with no increase in the tax rate for voters.**

Why Now?

While the 2018 Bond significantly improved every school and kept its promises to voters, many of our facilities continue to age, grow in enrollment, or require modernization. The 2025 bond proposal is a proactive investment to:

- Address critical maintenance and repair needs
- Upgrade outdated safety and security systems
- Respond to shifting demographics and enrollment patterns
- Plan responsibly for the future—without raising tax rates

Common Sense Approach to Meet Needs

Numerous repair or replacement projects for schools in the district have been delayed for several years due to budget limitations, leading to issues such as leaking roofs, outdated electrical wiring and failing heating systems.

Multiple schools have heating or cooling systems that are extremely outdated, to the point where repairs are no longer possible. These aging systems, some of which are over 50 years old, must be replaced to keep schools operating properly.

The \$99 million bond includes

- Critical maintenance projects throughout the district
- Safety and security upgrades to help keep students and staff safe
- Additional space to meet the needs of a growing population

An independent committee of community members and Thompson School District personnel will provide oversight and public reports about how EVERY penny of this new money is being spent.
