Use AI as a Support, Not a Shortcut

AI can brainstorm, explain, and give feedback—but your own ideas, effort, and creativity come first.

Protect Your Integrity

Always cite AI assistance in schoolwork. Avoid copying word-for-word responses. Your work should reflect your own thinking.



Think Critically

AI is not perfect. It can be biased, outdated, or wrong. Ask: *Does this make sense? Is it fair? What's missing?*

Guard Your Privacy

Never share personal info (like your address, student ID, or health records) with AI tools. Use only district-approved platforms that follow FERPA and COPPA laws.



Respect Your Digital Footprint

Everything you post, create, or share leaves a trace. Build a positive online reputation by being respectful, honest, and responsible.

Promote Fairness & Equity

Be aware that AI tools may carry hidden biases. Use AI in ways that are inclusive and respectful of all people.



Keep Learning

AI changes quickly. Stay curious, keep asking questions, and be ready to adapt.
