Cell Phone Policy



Beginning this fall, **New York State** is prohibiting the use of cell phones and personal internet-enabled devices during the entire school day for **all public school students**.

NEW YORK STATE LAW § 2803 >

In accordance with this State rule, East Ramapo students **may not use personal cell phones or other devices** that connect to the internet while on school property for the **entire school day**.

You can read the complete Board-Adopted policy below, as well as find more information about how the cell phone ban will be implemented in East Ramapo.

STUDENT LOCKERS



DO WEAR CLOTHING APPROPRIATE FOR SCHOOL:

- Clothing serves the purpose of privacy
- Clothing covers the back, chest, stomach, bottom, and private areas
- Close-toed shoes are required at the elementary level at all times (no slippers or house shoes). Middle and high school students may wear open-toed shoes (no slippers, house shoes or flip flops)



*Elementary: NO open toe

DO NOT WEAR CLOTHING OR ACCESSORIES THAT:

- Are a disruption to the learning environment, including:
 - Clothing that displays obscene material, profanity, vulgar statements, gang symbols, hate messages, sexual innuendos, suicide, intolerance, violent messages, references to subversion or other messages which may be interpreted as being inappropriate or offensive
 - Sagging pants, bottoms shorter than mid-thigh, shorts that expose any portion of the buttocks, clothes/jeans with rips or holes above mid-thigh, midriff- or abdomen-baring tops, open mesh clothing without proper clothing underneath, or tank tops with exposed undergarments
- Are intended to be undergarments or sleepwear
 - Examples: a-shirts, undershirts, camisole tops, pajama tops, pajama bottoms
- Promotes illegal use by minors such as alcohol, tobacco or drugs
- The following accessories are NOT permitted:
 - Any headgear, including hats and hoods worn over the head, unless approved by the administration
 - Headgear worn as part of religious expression is exempt from this section of policy per administrator discretion
 - Sunglasses may not be worn in school unless prescribed by a doctor



*NO Hoods on head

Dressing in any manner that presents a health or safety hazard or is a disruption, or could reasonably be expected to cause disruption, to the educational environment in the school will not be accepted. Administrators will enact the required and optional range of responses in situations where a student is not meeting the expectations of the dress code. The goal is to resolve the situation in the moment and prevent it from occurring again.

Student Dress Code

All students are expected to give proper attention to personal cleanliness and to dress appropriately for school and school functions. Students and their parents have the primary responsibility for acceptable student dress and appearance. Teachers and all other District personnel should exemplify and reinforce acceptable student dress and help students develop an understanding of appropriate appearance in the school setting. A student's dress, grooming and appearance, including hair style/color, jewelry, make-up and nails, shall:

1. Be safe, appropriate and not disrupt or interfere with the educational process.
2. Recognize that extremely brief garments such as tube tops, net tops, halter tops, tops over leggings, spaghetti straps, tank tops, muscle shirts, plunging necklines (front and/or back), short shorts, short skirts, and see-through garments are not appropriate.
3. Ensure that underwear is completely covered with outer clothing – no sagging pants.
4. Not including wearing pajamas as clothing.
5. Include footwear at all times. Footwear that is a safety hazard will not be allowed.
6. Not include the wearing of hats or other headwear in school except for a medical or religious purpose.
7. Not include items that are vulgar, obscene, libelous or denigrate others on account of race, color, religion, creed, national origin, gender, sexual orientation or disability.
8. Not promote and/or endorse the use of alcohol, tobacco or illegal drugs and/or encourage other illegal, gang-related, or violent activities.
9. Not include the wearing of either prescription or non-prescription sunglasses except for medical or other purposes approved by school officials.
10. Not expose to public view the abdomen, midriff, or exposed skin between the garment and skirt, pants or shorts.
11. Be protected under the provisions of the CROWN Act and the Commissioner's Regulations regarding DASA ((100.2 (j)), (kk)).

Each building principal or designee shall be responsible for informing all students and their parents of the student dress code at the beginning of the school year and any revisions to the dress code made during the school year.

The New York State Education Department requires that students are healthy and current on vaccinations. Your child will need a completed School Health Examination Form within the first week of attendance.
