

Students will simply practice moving out of sight, staying quiet, and following their teacher's directions until an "All Clear" is given. These drills are always done in a calm, age-appropriate way and are not meant to scare students. Our goal is to help them feel confident and prepared.

By practicing together, we help keep our school community safe while also supporting our district's focus on safety, security, and a positive school culture.
