

## The Kathy Krueger Student Support Fund 2025-26

### Financial Assistance Opportunities Available at Seattle Prep

This fund is available **to all students who receive a tuition grant** and is made possible by generous donations from Prep donors, including our faculty and staff. Seattle Preparatory School understands that there are several costs associated with the day-to-day attendance at school in addition to tuition. To help our families with these essential needs, a summary of programs offered is listed below. Fee reductions and assistance are as follows:

**One-to-One Learning Program:** Students are required to purchase a Microsoft Surface Pro laptop/tablet device from Prep as part of their enrollment process. A discount based on the table above is automatically given for the Surface charge to all students who receive a tuition grant. This reduction is reflected in the Enrollment Agreement. Students using the Surface on a loaner basis are required to return it upon the completion of their Prep enrollment.

**Morning Shuttle Assistance:** All students who receive a tuition grant will automatically receive a discount for the morning shuttle charge based on the table above.

**Registration and Activity Fees:** The Registration Fee (\$650) is reduced for all students who receive tuition assistance. Similarly, the Activity Fee (\$675) is reduced for all students who receive tuition assistance. These reductions are reflected in the Enrollment Agreement.

**Textbook/App Reimbursements (purchased by student):** Seattle Prep offers the Textbook Reimbursement Program to **students who receive a grant that covers at least 50% of their tuition**. Receipts for purchased books, apps, or other required texts must be submitted to the Accounting Office (in one batch please) via e-mail attachment or postal mail between September 1st and September 30th. Reimbursements will be mailed in October at a rate shown in the table above.

**Textbook/App Reimbursements (purchased by Prep for the student):** The school is often able to purchase books or apps in bulk at a discount. In these cases, charges for the item are placed on all Student Auxiliary Accounts. **Students who receive a grant that covers at least 50% of their tuition** will automatically receive credit on their Student Account at the rate of 50%, 75% or 100% per the table above.

**Lunch Assistance:** Students **who receive a grant that covers at least 75% of their tuition** may receive a lunch subsidy of \$20.00 per day added to their *MySchoolBucks* account monthly (amount dependent on the number of days in the month). Families are responsible for any charges incurred over the \$20.00 per day allowance.

**Miscellaneous Assistance Opportunities:** The Kathy Krueger Student Support Fund also covers items such as calculators, AP testing fees, etc. at a rate shown in the table above. Expendable office supplies such as paper, pencils, and binders are not covered. Submit receipts to the Accounting Office for reimbursement.
