A few months ago, the District partnered with SitelogIQ to complete a District-wide facilities maintenance plan. In short, the company has visited all of our buildings and grounds and carefully assessed the condition and age of buildings, grounds, systems, and equipment. We are working with SitelogIQ to now develop a long-range maintenance plan with full details about what we need to do in order to maintain our assets as well as how much it is likely to cost the District. We are currently working on arranging a public presentation from SitelogIQ during the month of October.
