

# Trigg County Primary School

3 years old for the 2025-2026 school year: (child will not be 4 until after August 2<sup>nd</sup>

## **Step 1: Universal Screening**

- a) Brigance screening will be provided in August. This screening looks at 5 developmental areas- Cognition, Language/ Communication, Fine & Gross Motor, Social Emotional, and Self-Help/ Adaptive.
- b) If your student passes the universal screener (scores 79 and above in any developmental area), then your child will not be eligible for preschool until they are 4 before August 1<sup>st</sup>.
- c) If your student scores 78 or below in any area, then they will move on to step 2

## **Step 2: Interventions provided in weekly TAG sessions at school**

- a) An intervention plan will be developed and weekly interventions will be provided in any developmental area with a score of 78 or below.
- b) Interventions will occur 1 time a week, they will last 30 minutes each session, for a minimum of 6 weeks.
- c) A rescreen will be provided after a minimum of 6 weeks.
  - 1) If your child continues to show potential delays then they will either
    - (a) Continue with interventions, but change frequency

**OR**

    - (b) Move to step 3
  - 2) If your child shows improvements in their scores and progress, then your child may continue to be provided interventions on a weekly basis at school or they may be dismissed from TAG services.

## **Step 3: Referral for Evaluation**

- a) A referral to an Admissions and Release Committee to determine whether further evaluation is necessary. This is to determine if the child needs special education and related services, which shall be considered.
- b) If an evaluation is warranted, then the school has 60 school days to complete the evaluation.
