General DASA Course

Intended Audience:

Individuals seeking DASA Certification to meet specific job requirement criteria.

Course Description

A comprehensive course on New York State's Dignity for All Students Act (DASA). Participants can choose between two options: a full-day, in-person course held on a Saturday, or a 5-day virtual asynchronous course. The asynchronous option allows participants to complete the 7 modules at their own pace, fitting it into their schedules. Course completion relies on the timely submission of materials from all participants. Both options provide an engaging and interactive learning experience. Upon completing the course and submitting all required materials, participants will be eligible to receive a certificate of completion.

Course Objective:

1. Develop a thorough understanding of the Dignity for All Students Act (DASA)
2. Recognize behaviors that qualify as bullying and harassment
3. Learn about the different types of bullying, including cyberbullying
4. Accurately identify reportable DASA incidents
5. Understand how to actively contribute to bullying prevention
6. Explore key elements for creating a safe and positive learning environment

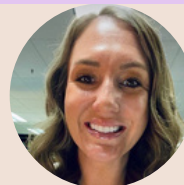

Dignity for All Students Act 2025-2026 DASA COORDINATOR COURSE

Course Description

DASA Coordinators and their Response Teams play a vital role in creating and maintaining a positive school climate by both preventing and addressing dignity violations. It's essential that DASA Coordinators are well-prepared to fulfill these responsibilities effectively. This full-day Comprehensive DASA Coordinator training is designed to equip participants with the knowledge and skills needed to support their school's DASA practices, policies, and procedures.

Course Objective

1. Develop a comprehensive understanding of the Dignity for All Students Act (DASA)
2. Understand the specific duties of the Dignity Act Coordinator
3. Learn about school district responsibilities, including DASA policies and required trainings
4. Differentiate between bullying, harassment, discrimination, and conflict
5. Recognize behaviors that qualify as bullying and harassment
6. Learn about the different types of bullying, including cyberbullying
7. Accurately identify reportable DASA incidents
8. Gain insights into vulnerable populations at risk for being targets
9. Guidance in evaluating your current DASA policies and practices and developing actionable steps for improvement.
