2025-2026 PARENT & FAMILY ENGAGEMENT POLICY

Poe Elementary School will build its own Parental and Family Engagement Policy and support the capacity for strong parental involvement, to ensure effective involvement of parents and guardians, and to support a partnership among Poe, parents and guardians, and the community we serve to improve student academic achievement.

Annual Title I Parent Meeting: At the beginning of each school year, we invite the parents and guardians of all children who participate in the Title I program to an annual meeting to discuss the requirements of at Title I school. Assessment scores and the Campus Action Plan for the school are discussed. At this meeting, we share Title I law, its requirements, and the rights and benefits to parents and guardians of the children involved.

Program Involvement/Additional Parent Meetings: At the Annual Meeting and other meetings throughout the year, we give parents of participating children timely information about our Title I programs. We describe and explain our expectations for students and explain how we track student growth and achievement over their time with us at Poe.

School-Parent Compact: The School-Parent Compact explains how parents, school staff, and the student will all share responsibility for each student's academic success.

Building Capacity for Involvement: An aspect of Poe's partnership with parents and guardians is to provide additional opportunities for involvement in their student's educational experience. Parents and guardians will be provided with information regarding state educational standards, early literacy curriculum, and social-emotional development in meetings throughout the school year.

Accessibility: Information related to student achievement, school performance, school and parent programs, meetings and other opportunities will be provided both in a physical form through our Daily Folders as well as through regular communication via the *Weekly View* online newsletter, in English and Spanish by default. Additional opportunities and news may be broadcast regularly by teachers and administrators through the ParentSquare system. Parents and guardians are encouraged to provide any changes in contact information so that they continue to receive timely updates.

Parental Comments: Regular meetings are offered to parents and guardians to make a suggestion, share experiences, and participate in decisions relating to the education of their child. Parents are given the contact information for administrators and campus personnel to voice concerns or obtain additional information as needed.
