



Parent Square, Aeries, Homelink Information

ParentSquare/Aeries/Homelink Users can fine-tune their notification settings for posts for each school and district. For General Announcements, you can select Digest, Instant, or choose to turn off notifications altogether (excluding Urgent Alerts and notices.) You can choose to receive email, text, and/or app notifications. We do encourage parents and students to turn on the Instant Text messages so that you can receive timely OHS information directly to your phone. Students will only receive text messages if we have their cell phone on file in Aeries. To learn how to set up your notifications, please review this document.

Parents/Guardians also will receive weekly emails/texts from Aeries that send direct information about student grades and attendance. If texting alerts are set up this will go directly to your phone. Although it is automatically set up for you, you can <u>review the instructions here</u> and you can adjust the date of the week and time you receive these messages.

Attention All Drivers!

Unauthorized Parking Will Result in Tickets and Towing!

- Visitor Parking Reserved for Visitors only. (Clearly marked Visitor)
- Handicap Parking Must have a handicap placard.
- Other open spots Must have a current OHS Parking Pass.



Water Safety Grade 9

All PE9 students will begin the water safety unit on September 8. This unit is 15 days and includes concepts, rules and skills of safety, including floating, swimming, recovery strokes, rescuing others without becoming a victim, escaping riptides, etc. This is a state-mandated unit and is not optional without a valid, recent doctor's note. Students who cannot get in the water will be required to learn and videotape all skills on dryland. All students who haven't learned to swim will be taught in the shallow end, with flotation devices. It is HIGHLY recommended that non-swimmers take swim lessons between now and the water safety unit as there are 45+ students in our classes and only one teacher so individual instruction is minimal.

Required items:

Appropriate bathing suit (or Nike pros and a sports bra, board shorts, rash guards) goggles, hairband, towel, sandals, water bottle, sunscreen, plastic bag. Families needing support in getting the required gear can speak directly with their counselor.


