GPA Bike Safety Expectations

We expect all GPA students to follow the guidelines listed below to be eligible to bring their bike on campus. Any student who is not following these expectations will have their riding privileges suspended or revoked. Bringing a bike to school is a privilege, not a right.

All California bike safety rules must be followed on campus which includes motor traffic laws, helmet laws and bicycle safety laws.

Motorbikes or dirtbikes are not allowed on campus. All E-bikes must be street legal and safe for minors to operate on public streets.

At no time are bicycles allowed to be ridden on our school campus.

When entering campus follow the traffic flow to the dirt lot. Exiting campus, you can walk your bike through campus to the pedestrian gate or ride out the dirt lot following the flow of traffic. You must follow all directions from staff when bringing a bike on or off campus.

Helmets must be worn and buckled at all times.

You are responsible for locking and securing your bike. The school is not responsible for any damages to bicycles.

The bicycle storage area has a camera so make sure you are not touching or messing with another student's bike.
