- Synthesizing ideas while reading and forming opinions for writing.

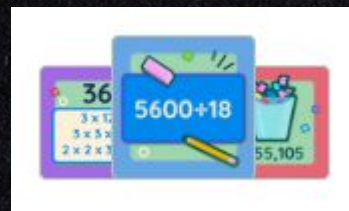
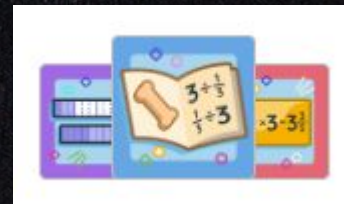
