The Cherokee County NAACP Branch is excited to announce its **STEM Scholarship Program**. The program was developed with the intent of providing assistance and resources to students living in Cherokee County who wish to pursue college or career readiness programs beyond high school. *Once again, scholarships are in the form of laptop computers to be awarded to one graduating senior from each of Cherokee County School District's seven high schools.*

Applicant must be an African American who is planning to attend an accredited/certified, post-secondary institution, and is planning to pursue coursework in a STEM related field. The attached document fully outlines the application process. **The deadline to submit all parts of the application is by 5 pm on September 5, 2025.** All applicants will be notified of the status/outcome of their application by September 12, 2025.

The Cherokee County NAACP Branch is a nonprofit organization whose members work to promote civil rights and social justice within the community. We aspire to create a footprint in the community not only through our advocacy work, but also by our philanthropic contributions to our community.

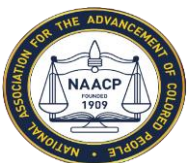

2025 SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM APPLICATION FORM AND INFORMATION

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ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Applicants to the *Cherokee County NAACP STEM Scholarship Program* **must** meet the following eligibility requirements:

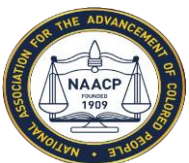
- **US Citizen residing in Cherokee County, Ga,**
- **Current Cherokee County School District high school senior**
- **An African American**
- **GPA of 3.0 or better on a 4-point scale**
- **Plan to pursue post-secondary education at an accredited/certified institution**
- **Plan to pursue coursework in a STEM-related field (science, technology, engineering, or mathematics)**

Note: Applicant is not required to be a member of the Cherokee County NAACP Unit; however, applicant might consider joining a Chapter's Youth Program in the area or at the post-secondary institution of attendance.

SELECTION CRITERIA

The criteria used to select award recipients include academic performance, character, educational and career goals, and an interview. **Each of these criteria carries equal weight in determining who will receive an award.**

- *Academic performance* is determined by evaluating the high school transcript released to the NAACP by the applicant. Applicants must possess a minimum of a 3.0 grade point average on a 4.0 scale or its equivalent.
- *Character* will be assessed using references provided by individuals the applicant selects. **PERSONAL REFERENCES FROM FRIENDS AND RELATIVES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**
- *Educational and career goals* (with a STEM focus) will be evaluated through examination of an essay written by the student and by interview questions.
- Applicants **must** participate in an interview conducted by the STEM Scholarship Selection Committee. The interview will allow the committee to personally meet the student and to ask additional/clarifying questions.



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DESCRIPTION OF AWARD

Each award will be a **Laptop Computer** provided to the selected students. An award is being offered to *one graduating senior from **each** of Cherokee County School District's seven high schools*. In the event there are no applicants from a high school, it is the sole discretion of the Cherokee County NAACP STEM Scholarship Selection Committee to determine if and how the award will be used. The laptop computer's make, model and specifications is determined by the Cherokee County NAACP STEM Scholarship Selection Committee.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

All awards will be made during the **Cherokee County NAACP's Freedom Fund Banquet** event to be held on Friday, October 17, 2025, from 7 pm – 10 pm, at The Timbers on Etowah, located at 225 Reformation Pkwy, Canton, GA 30114. **Award recipients are required to attend the event (at no cost) to be recognized and to receive the award.**

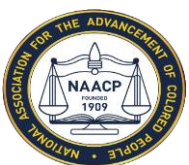
APPLICATION PROCEDURE

There are four essential parts of this application. All parts must be received by the deadline in order for The STEM Scholarship Selection Committee to consider an application. The deadline for completed applications is by 5 pm on September 5, 2025. ***Applicants who do not complete/submit all parts of the application are not eligible for an award.***

All **Parts I, II, III, and IV** (listed below) are to be submitted. Electronic submissions are to be sent to cherokeecountynaACP@gmail.com or mailed to:

- I. **Application Form** – The Application Form (2 pages) contains basic information about the applicant. All sections of the application form must be completed, ***including*** the applicant's and parent/guardian statement with signatures.
- II. **Official Transcript** - An official grade transcript must show the courses you have taken and the grades awarded. ***It must be dated within 30 days of submission and signed by a counselor or registrar.*** The transcript will allow the STEM Selection Committee to evaluate academic performance. Students should request their transcripts ASAP from their school guidance department. It is acceptable for the transcript to be submitted from the school guidance department.

- III. **Reference Form – Two references are required.** Utilize the attached reference form to secure a reference. This reference should come from a person who has first-hand knowledge of your functioning as a student on a regular basis and your character. The NAACP STEM Cherokee County Scholarship Program Committee assumes that recommendations from teachers, guidance counselors, principals, sponsors, coaches and/or other school personnel can better provide information regarding a student’s future performance in school than personal recommendations. AS A RESULT, THIS RECOMMENDATION SHOULD COME FROM THE AFOREMENTIONED TYPE INDIVIDUALS. **REFERENCES FROM RELATIVES AND PERSONAL REFERENCES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.** It is acceptable for the reference to be submitted directly from the persons completing the reference form.
- IV. **Essay** – All applicants must complete the *REQUIRED ESSAY* as described below. If an applicant’s transcript reflects any “D” or “F” grades or withdrawals from a class at any time, the applicant must **also** complete the *CONDITIONAL ESSAY* as described below.

Part A – REQUIRED ESSAY

The Cherokee County NAACP STEM Scholarship Program is making an investment in YOU. *We are interested in assisting you with a successful future. Show us that you have thought about it and are interested in a successful STEM future as well!* As such, the selection committee would like to gain insight into your history as a student, your motivations, and the next steps toward your future.

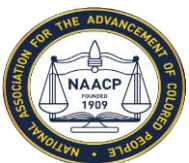
In an essay of approximately 400 words (typed in Times New Roman 12 font with 1’ margins or neatly printed), please explain specifically: ·

- **Your Academic focus:** What will be your STEM major, trade profession or field of study? Why did you choose it? How have you prepared for it?
- **Your Proficiency and skill level:** What skills do you possess that make this focus a great match for you?
- **Your Career goal:** What will be your objective immediately upon graduation from your STEM program?
- **Your Future plan:** What actions will you take to achieve that goal or employment?

Part B - CONDITIONAL ESSAY

If your transcript reflects any “D” or “F” grades or withdrawals from a class at any time, please provide an additional essay of approximately 200 words (*typed in Times New Roman 12 font with 1’ margins or neatly printed*), to explain specifically: ·

- **What happened?**
- **What did you learn from allowing your grades to slip?**
- **What has changed or what will you do differently in future studies?**

NOTIFICATION PROCEDURE

The selection committee will meet to review all submitted documents. All applicants will be notified of the status/outcome of their application by September 12, 2025. **Final award recipients will be notified by September 30, 2025.**
