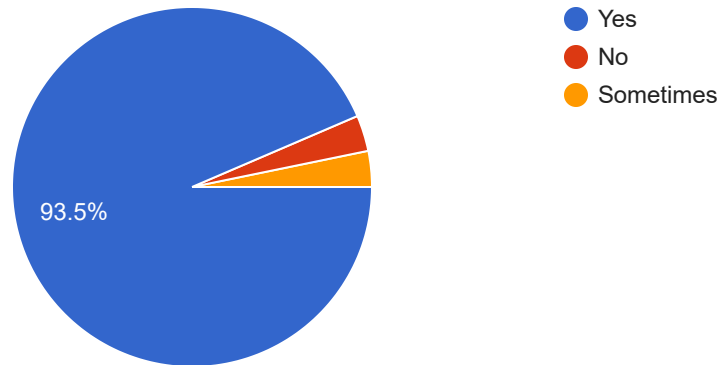

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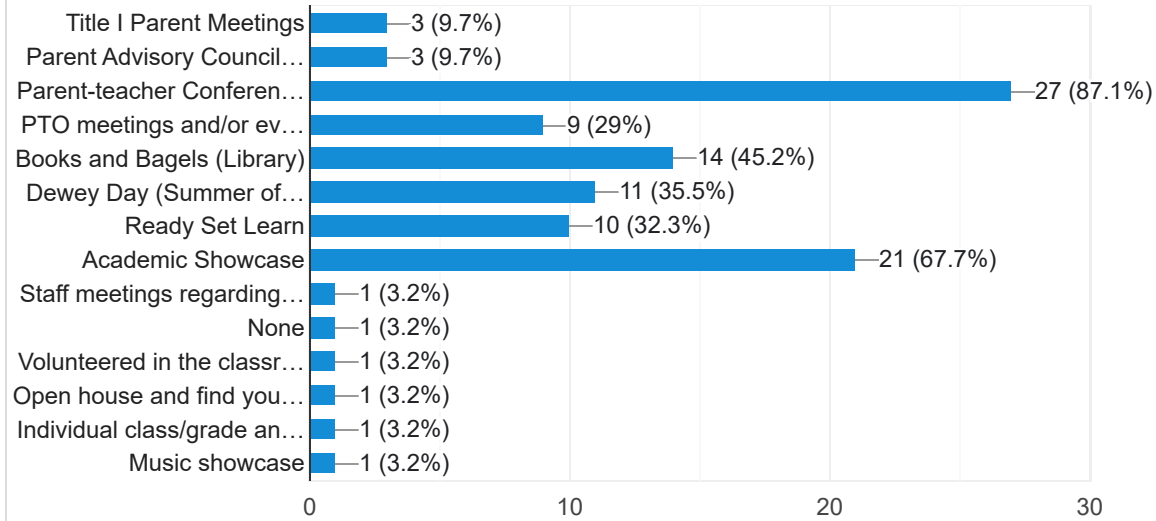

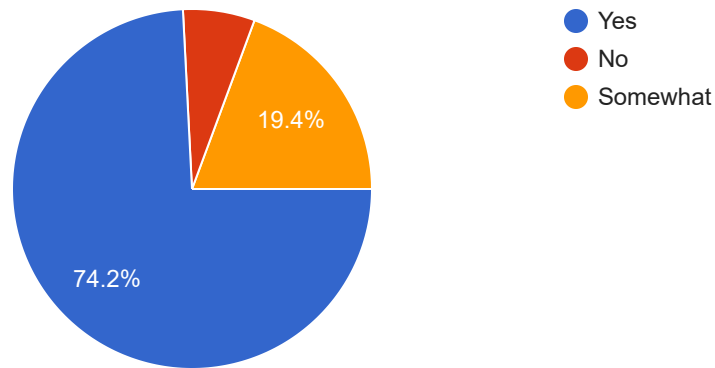

Are you aware of what your child is expected to understand in all subject areas?



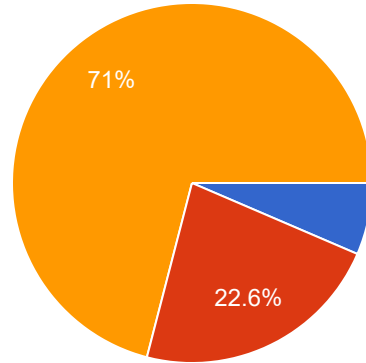

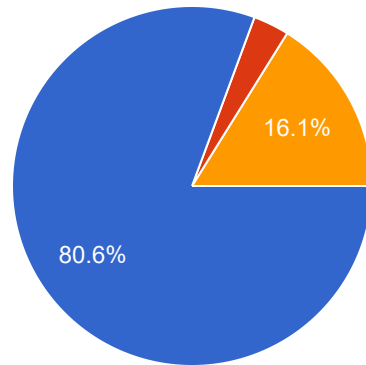

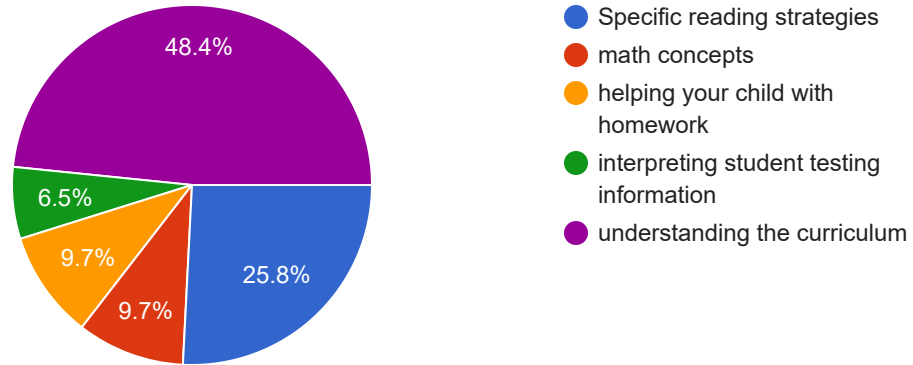

Honestly, just knowing what they're learning with more input would be helpful. If the teacher would recap weekly via Seesaw what the subject/unit number is, what it covers, what sheets to reference with additional tips for homework and practice at home would be that'd be amazing. The school just sends home SO MUCH via announcements, and other Seesaw messages, the handouts stack and it's overwhelming. Challenging to keep it all straight with multiple kiddos!

Right now, the handouts come home every Friday, and they're sometimes lost in the mix of take home papers, so items just a scramble! So, if there was event where parents could come and purchase a binder/book of the worksheets and stuff to review ahead of time, that'd be way more ideal, rather than trying to piece everything together from what comes home via the kids.
