Selection Criteria: Students attending PCSD high schools that have turned in an application by the deadline will be registered first. Students attending member charter schools and/or online schools that have turned in application by the deadline will be registered second. Students that turn applications in after the deadlines, regardless of school attending, will be placed on a waitlist if the program is already full. If a program is oversubscribed, students will be selected based on attendance and disciplinary records.
