

PSAT Parent Letter

Dear Parent/Guardian:

The Middle Country Central School District, in support of students' post-secondary planning and college options, encourages all students to take the PSAT exam, which is a practice for the SAT exam for college admissions. For 11th graders, the PSAT is also the National Merit Scholarship qualifying test, which provides students opportunities for awards and scholarships. We highly encourage all 10th and 11th graders to take this exam!

In the 2025-2026 school year, the PSAT will be offered to all 10th and 11th graders on Saturday, October 18th, 2025 in both high schools. The PSAT is taken on students' District-issued Chromebooks through an application called Blue Book.

The PSAT is offered by the district free of charge, but **students must pre-register by September 17th, 2025 through a Google form**, which is available here and on the website.

Please mark your calendars for October 18th, 2025 for the PSAT for all 10th and 11th graders. This is the date that students can take the exam, and there is no makeup date.

If your child has testing accommodations through an IEP or 504 plan, and wishes to take the PSAT or SAT with testing accommodations, approval must be submitted directly to College Board through your child's guidance counselor.
