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### Clinical School Social Worker Support Services

- Evidence-Based Education, Behavior and Mental Health Services
- School wide Interventions
- Group Counseling
- Individual Counseling
- Case Management
- Crisis Intervention
- Supportive Counseling

### Services To Parent/Families

- Working with parents to facilitate their support in their children's school adjustment
- Alleviating family stress to enable the child to function more effectively in school and community
- Assisting parents to access programs available to students
- Assisting parents in accessing and utilizing school and community resources

### Services to Students

- Providing crisis intervention (i.e trauma, suicidal ideations)
- Developing intervention strategies to increase academic success
- Providing mental health services with grief and loss, self-esteem, anger management, anxiety, among others
- Helping the child develop appropriate social interaction skills
- Assisting the child in understanding and accepting self and others

### Project Access Support Services

- Individual/Group Counseling
- Case Management
- School Supplies
- Bus Tickets, if eligible
- Community Resources
- Provides support for extracurricular school activities

### School Psychologist Support Services

- Provides academic, behavioral and mental health supports
- Assist with creating behavioral plans
- Attend SSTs and 504 meetings
- Conduct evaluations/assessments and educational data analysis in order to determine whether a student meets the eligibility criteria for Special Education services
- Provide crisis prevention, response and postvention (suicide risk assessments and threat assessments)

### Prodigy Support Services

- Provides evidence-based substance use counseling services which includes motivational interviewing, psycho-education, Trauma informed treatment, gang intervention, Cognitive Behavioral Therapy, Early intervention, and Relapse Prevention
- Operates year round, ensuring continuous support and services for students (school breaks, care may be offered through a range of services such as telehealth sessions, in-person sessions, and community-based sessions)
