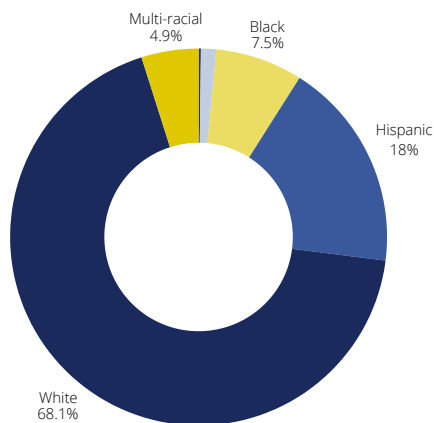

School

Avon Grove Charter High School is a public high school, accredited by Pennsylvania Department of Education and The Middle State Association of Secondary Schools and Colleges. Our school consists of students from over eleven surrounding public-school districts including (but not limited to): Avon Grove, Coatesville, Downingtown, Kennett-Consolidated, Octorara, Oxford, Solanco, and Unionville. The total enrollment in 2023 for Avon Grove Charter School is 1,857 students. The high school supported over 400 students and a graduating class of 98.

Community

Avon Grove Charter School is located in a rural-suburban setting, approximately thirty-five miles southwest of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, and twenty miles northwest of Wilmington, Delaware. The area is populated by families employed in a wide range of service, trade, technical, and professional occupations.

Curriculum

Students at Avon Grove Charter School are offered an extensive curriculum with academic focal areas in Performing and Visual Arts, Environmental Science, and STEM. The school's student-teacher ratio is 15:1. All required, core courses are arranged by level of rigor and difficulty. Students are heterogeneously grouped in non-core academic courses. AGCS offers courses at the general grade level, college preparatory, honors, and advanced placement levels.

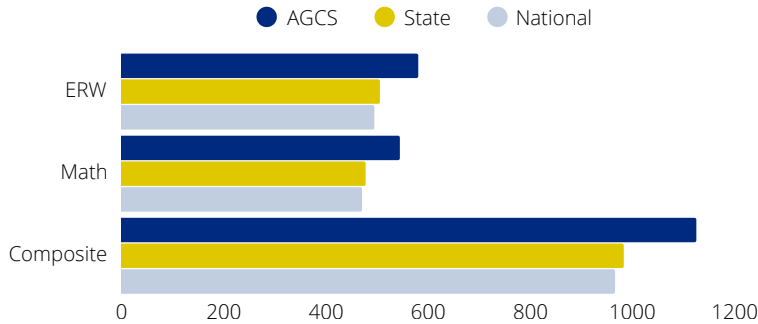

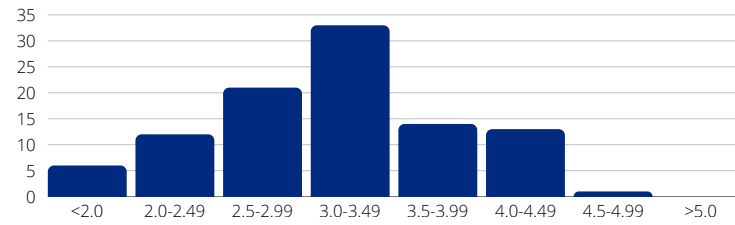
SAT Mean Scores (Class of 2026)
