My Daily Responsibilities

 - I will never leave my device alone.
 - I will carry my device with two hands and keep it in a safe place.
 - I will only take my device outside the classroom if my teacher says it's okay.
 - I will keep my device on a table or desk when I use it.
 - I will make sure my device is not noisy or distracting.
 - I will keep food and drinks away from my device.

- I will only go to websites my teacher says are okay.
 - I will stay on task and use my device for learning.
 - If I see something that looks wrong or inappropriate, I will go back and tell my teacher right away.
 - My device is my responsibility—I won't let anyone else use it.
 - I will only use AI (Artificial Intelligence) if my teacher gives me permission.

- I will not take or share pictures or videos of classmates without permission.
- I will not go to websites that are not for school.
- I will not use someone else's email or pretend to be someone else.
- I will not damage or draw on my device or anyone else's.
- I will not try to change passwords or settings on my device or someone else's.
