These independent learning tasks should be completed by 18.10.25. Pupils are expected to complete all tasks. All completed tasks will be rewarded with positive points.

Reading: Pupils in years 3 to 6 follow the Reading Eggs programme and should be completing this 5 times a week for 20 minutes, working through the levels and maps, along with completing the weekly assignments set by their teacher. Pupils should access the library area of the programme in addition to this and read a variety of books. Please contact your child's teacher if you need a reminder of your child's login details.

Mathematics and numeracy

Make your own board game using a variety of times tables.
Will you make a set of question cards to answer if you land on a question mark? Will a player miss a turn if they answer the question incorrectly?
Further weekly tasks will appear on Google Classroom.

English, literacy and communication

Write an adventure story with a made up monster like our class novel Frankenstein.
Will you make a character good or bad? Will your character have a power? Where will your character go on their adventure?
