

Core Classes

Core classes, including Mathematics, English Language Arts, Science, and Social Studies, are fundamental subjects that provide essential knowledge and skills for students' academic and professional success.

Elective Classes

Additional opportunities for interested students wishing to add experiences like band, choir, world language, etc. to their school day. Electives are selected by the student and family and are scheduled for the entire school year.

Enhanced Pathway Discovery

Exploratory Classes

Extracurricular Opportunities
