## POLICY, PRACTICES AND PROCEDURE INFORMATION

### REWARDS AND INCENTIVES

Rewards and incentive items will not include edible items, including but not limited to, candy, mints, snacks and beverages. Conversely, withholding food or beverages as a form of punishment is not allowed.

### FUNDRAISERS

Non-edible items, physical activity, and academic pursuits will be the expectation for fundraisers. If edible items are used for fundraisers, items will be consistent with the Smart Snacks Guidelines. All fundraisers must be approved by building administration.

### PHYSICAL ACTIVITY

Withholding physical activity, such as recess, physical education, and more, as a negative consequence is not allowed. Additionally, staff and partners will not use physical activity as a negative consequence. Note: MN Legislation also states that recess may not be withheld as a consequence.

### Cultural and Religious Observances

Spaces will be accessible for stakeholders to observe cultural and religious practices.

### FRAGRANCE FRIENDLY ENVIRONMENTS

BCCS supports a fragrance-friendly environment. The use of artificially scented products is discouraged. This includes products that produce a scent strong enough to be perceived by others.
