



JAG DESIGN

This course is designed for students to run a business embedded in the school. The full range of business operations will be explored and put into real world practice. Students will learn and master real world, hands on skills for designing and producing textiles that can be applied directly to the workforce.

Course Expectations & Classroom Policies:

- Be respectful, responsible and ready to learn.
- Do not abuse your privilege of leaving the room. You must have permission and a pass to leave the room for any reason.
- All supplies need to be neatly put away in YOUR designated container at the end of each period.
- When you are absent from class it is your responsibility to make up the time that you missed and arrange for a time to meet with us individually if necessary.
- We have a designated class time, please be prompt as we have lots to get done in a short period. Others are counting on us to create and produce items in a timely manner.
- Remain FOCUSED at the task at hand and treat ALL items as if you were making them for yourself. Each mistake costs money in materials and supplies that are necessary to run and operate our course.
- As per the district policy, the only electronic device allowed in class is the school issued iPad.
- All other school rules, regulations and code of conduct apply in this class.

Grading Policy:

- Attendance is crucial for Jag Design. Please be in class, on time and ready to work!
- Since our class is project based, most of the work must be completed during class time each day. There is very little work given to complete outside of class if you are focused and working hard throughout the period each day.
- Our course is graded on daily participation and design assignments. This includes, but is not limited to:
 - The Jag Design Order Accountability Form
 - Being in class and **productively** working.
 - When you complete one task, you need to find another productive task to work on.
 - If you are unsure about what to do next, ask one of your teachers or peers.
 - Each class period you will have the opportunity to earn full, daily participation points. You must be **productively** working for the duration of the period in order to earn full, daily points.
 - Creating meaningful, unique designs based on the assignments.
 - Providing and receiving constructive feedback from classmates and teachers.
- If students are unhappy with their grade they are strongly encouraged have a conversation with their teachers in order to make changes and improvements to future grades. Students may also ask for extra credit opportunities to improve their grade.

Equipment:

Jag Design allows us to use different equipment that needs to be treated properly and used appropriately. If you are unsure how to use something, make sure you ask for help. If the equipment is not used properly, it can cause harm to the user and/or the equipment. You **MUST** be familiar and confident with each piece of equipment to ensure your safety and the safety of all others in the class.

Behavior Expectations:

- We expect that everyone in class is respected at all times. Disrespect will not be tolerated.
- Misbehavior will be handled individually and follow these procedures as well as discipline procedure outlined in the code of conduct:
 - One warning
 - Contact parent(s)
 - Referral to the Principal
 - Removal from class
