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What is Title I?

Jackson High is identified as a Title I school as part of the “Every Student Succeeds Act” (also known as ESSA).

Title I is designed to support state and local school reform efforts tied to the challenging state academic standards to improve teaching and learning for students.

Title I programs must be based on effective means of improving student achievement and include strategies to support family engagement. All Title I schools must jointly develop with parents and members a written parent and family engagement policy.

School Plan for Shared Student Achievement

What is it?

This is a plan that describes how Jackson High School will provide opportunities to improve family engagement to support student learning. Jackson High values the contributions and involvement of parents and family members to establish an equal partnership for the common goal of improving student achievement. How is it revised?

If the school-level Parent Engagement Coordinator receives comments from parents advising the plan is unsatisfactory, the district-level Parent Engagement Coordinator will be notified immediately.

Who is it for?

Jackson High is a school-wide Title I school. All students participating in the Title I, Part A program, and their families are encouraged and invited to fully participate in the opportunities described in this plan. Jackson High will provide full opportunity for the participation of parents and family members with limited English, with disabilities and of migratory children.

Where is it available?

At the beginning of the year, the plan is sent home with students during the first month of school once it has been revised. The plan will also be posted on the school’s website and/or parents can retrieve a copy of the plan in the front office.

Increase % of students scoring at or above grade level on their Lexile band according to the Literature and Composition II results.

2025-2026 School Goals

During the 2025-2026 school year, JHS will increase the % of students scoring at or above grade level on their Lexile band according to the Literature and Composition II results from 59% (projection) to 61% by consistently and explicitly providing vocabulary instruction in all classrooms.

Reservation of Funds

Parents of children in Title I, Part A schools, will have opportunities via: a) Stakeholders Meeting and/or b) feedback forms and surveys to provide input into how the funds from the minimum 1% reservation are allotted.

School-Parent Compacts

As part of this plan, Jackson High School and our families will develop a school-parent compact, which is an agreement that parents, teachers, and students will share responsibility for improved student academic achievement. It describes how the school and parents will build and develop a partnership that will help children achieve the state's high standards. The compacts will be reviewed and updated annually based on feedback. The compacts are discussed with parents during parent-teacher conferences and a copy is sent home.
