

Discipline**Student Cell Phone Usage**

Developments in cell phone technology in recent years have resulted in enhanced communication opportunities. However, the use of cell phones in schools poses increasing risks of school disruptions, bullying, criminal activity, and academic dishonesty. As a result, student cell phones, digital cameras and similar electronic devices will be banned during the school day, as well as, in dressing areas during extracurricular activities. Violation of this policy during the first semester after adoption of this policy will result in:

- First offense - student receives a warning, phone is confiscated to office, where parent can pick up.
- Second offense - student receives 2 days of ISS, phone is confiscated to office, where parent can pick up.
- Third offense - student receives 1 day of OSS, phone is confiscated to office, where parent can pick up.
- For all further offenses, the student will receive an additional day of OSS, and the phone will be confiscated to office, where parent can pick up.

Parents may apply to the building principal to obtain a hardship exception. In such cases, the student's cell phone must be retained in the principal's office. Students granted a hardship may visit the office to use their cell phone for approved purposes. Telephones are also available in school offices for parents to contact their students for legitimate reasons. In addition, exceptions to this Policy may be made based upon the provisions of a student's IEP, §504 Plan and Safety Plan.

Immunity

School employees and volunteers are immune from liability provided that they are acting in good faith and are adhering to this Policy's disciplinary procedures.
