Are you interested in serving as a parent representative on the Luther School Site Council? Every school is required to develop a School Site Plan that outlines how our programs meet state quality standards in areas such as curriculum, staff development, parent involvement, budget, and compliance. A key part of this process is the School Site Council (SSC), and advisory council composed of equal representation from staff and parents.

The SSC plays a critical role in reviewing and monitoring the progress of school programs. Members are elected for two-year terms and meet four to five times per year in the afternoons on Zoom. The first meeting is scheduled on October 7 at 2:45 p.m. We currently have four open parent representative positions – an excellent opportunity to actively participate in your child's education and make a meaningful impact.
