

September 6, 2025 is National Read A Book Day! We would like to encourage each of you to sit down and read a book to your child today. When we read to our children, they realize the importance of reading!





We would like to thank Mrs. Sandy Huff for all she does for ECES! She keeps all our technology running and organized! We could not make it without her!




Arts In Education Week (9/14-9/20)
