- What are the requirements to apply to the Math & Science Magnet Program?
 - The applicant must be a resident of New Jersey.
 - The applicant must be enrolled in or have completed Algebra 1 in their middle school.
- Is there an admissions test?
 - Yes, please see our [website](#) for more details
- Can I arrange a school visit before applying?
 - No. Accepted students can shadow a current student once admitted into the program.
- Can students apply to the program after they have started grade 9?
 - Yes - students can apply to the program during their freshman year, provided they are enrolled in Biology 1 Honors, Geometry Honors, and Algebra II Honors. Applications are only accepted if there is a space available.
 - Once a student starts grade 10, they are no longer eligible to apply to the Magnet Program.
- Can students take Aviation classes while in the Magnet program?
 - Yes. Students can take any of our elective courses, provided they meet any pre- & co-requisites and there is space in their schedule.
