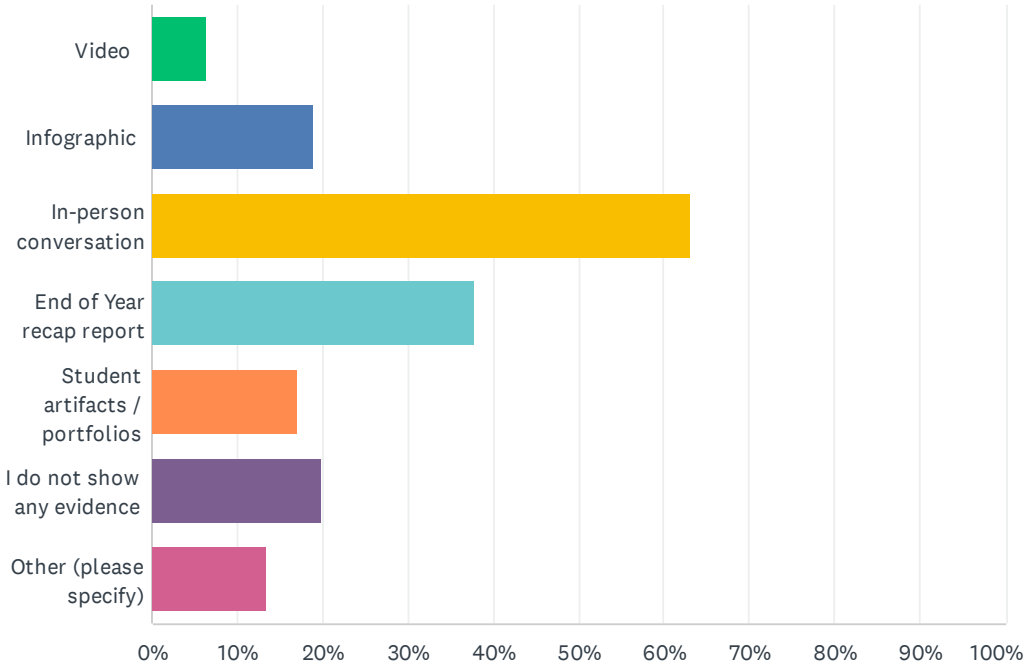

## Q21 How often do you use the Empire State Information Fluency Continuum (ESIFC) with your students?

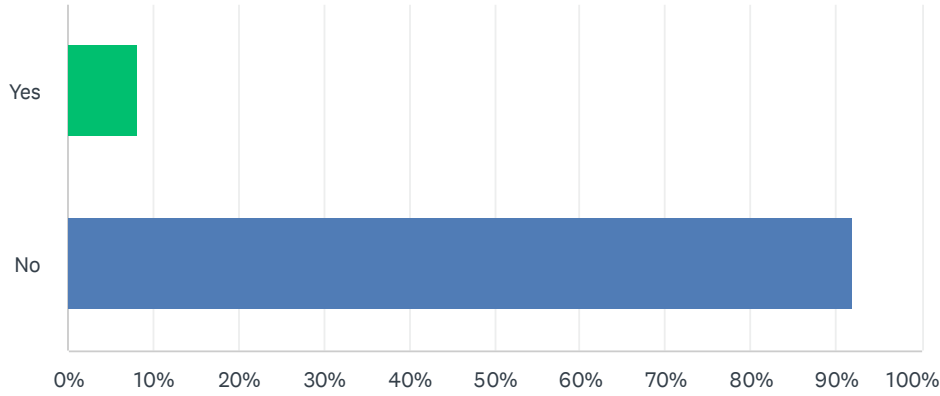
