**October 15, 2025**

- **Forming Teams & Defining Evaluation Standards:** Building an effective and representative adoption team and preparing your criteria for evaluation

- **Evaluating Curricula Using your Criteria:** Norming, calibrating, and comparing and moving beyond making decisions based on surface-level features to identify curricular features that *actually* support students and teachers.

**December 10, 2025**

- **Adoption and Beyond:** Making the final curriculum adoption decision, identifying who should be included in the decision-making process, and planning for implementation and next steps after adoption

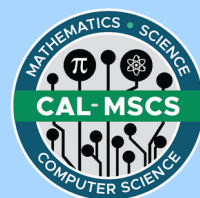
**January 14, 2026**
