Grades 9-12 Curriculum

BIS is an IB World School with English language instruction and a mother tongue programme. We do not rank students. Grade 10 take MYP eAssessments.

Calendar

Classes run from August-June. Academic reports take place twice per year: in February and June. External predicted grades are reported by December.

Scholarships

Our 16 high school scholarship students represent 10 countries. Scholarships are awarded based on family income and positive community impact.

Three Diploma Tracks

All students in Grades 9 - 12 follow a university preparatory programme:



High School Diploma: 100% of BIS students complete 24 credits in 4 years of full-time education with a minimum of 90% attendance. Pass mark is 3.



IB Courses and High School Diploma: 1-6 IB courses taken at the DP level.



IBDP and High School Diploma: All courses taken at the DP level with 3 HL and 3 SL subjects.
