Cans, Glass, Plastic Bottles, Batteries...

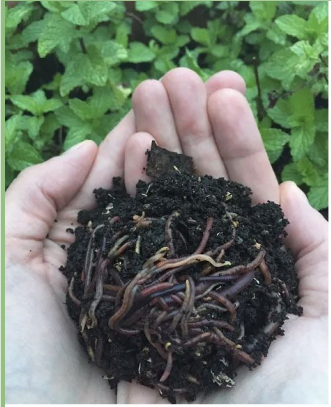

General trash collected every Tuesday. Place one sticker per 35l trash bag. Sticker prices below:

Plastics

Aluminium

Free of Charge

To be disposed in specified locations
Aluminium jars, and cans can go in the bucket.



Glass

Free of Charge

To be disposed in specified locations. It is required to separate white, brown, and green bottles.



Paper / Carton

Free of Charge (private use)

Paper and carton are to be separated and placed in boxes. Loose paper should be tied with straps. Place them wherever convenient, or where the neighbors put them. Only put them out on certain days, calendar is below.

Food Waste

Separate organic waste containers are used for the disposal of kitchen and food waste. Waste containers come in 4 different sizes: 60, 100, 150 and 270 litres (60 litres 200€, 100 litre 250€, 150 litre 300€ and 270 litre 450€). They can be found in Super All. On Monday night, you would bring it, include your house and Tuesday morning they pass by and empty the one leaving it back where they found it.

Just also accepts Sammelbecks - plastic recycling but NOT Tetrapaks. Buy a roll of Sammelbecks at Jost Recycling centre.



Aluminium

Free of Charge

To be disposed in specified locations

To be disposed in specified locations. It is required to separate white, brown, and green bottles.



Paper/ Carton

Free of Charge (private use)

Paper and carton are to be separated and placed in boxes, loose paper should be tied with strings. Place them wherever convenient, or where the neighbors put them. Only put them out on certain days, calendar is below.

Food Waste

Separate organic waste containers are needed for the disposal of kitchen and food waste. Waste containers come in 4 different sizes: 60, 100, 170 and 270 litres. 60 litres 750.-, 100 litres 850.-, 170 litres 1050.- and 270 litres 1500.-. They can be found in Super Aldi. On Monday night you would bring it outside your house and Tuesday morning they pick it up and empty the bin leaving it back where they found it.
