## CURRICULUM

Farragut operates on a block schedule with four 90-minute classes each semester. Students have the opportunity to earn 8 credits each year. Farragut offers a diverse program of study with hundreds of course offerings including Honors, Advanced Placement, and National Industry Certifications. An extensive Dual Enrollment program is offered through Pellissippi State Community College, East Tennessee State University, TCAT, and Lincoln Memorial University. Approximately 500 students are enrolled in 1300 dual enrollment classes each year. Farragut also offers 37 visual and performing arts classes, a 135-member choir, a 175-member band, and JROTC.

The 865 Academies were launched in 2022 in partnership with Ford Next Generation Learning. The innovative approach brings real-world learning right into the classroom. Farragut's 865 Academies are (1) Agriculture, Construction, & Leadership, (2) STEM & Design, (3) Health & Human Services, and (4) Business.
