As we embark on the exciting journey of constructing three new primary schools, we want to keep you informed every step of the way. Over the next three years, this transformational project will bring dynamic learning environments to life for our primary students and staff, and we are committed to sharing the progress with you.

That is why we are launching **Hammers & Horseshoes: The Wyoming Primary Schools Project Progress Report**, a monthly update designed to keep our staff, families, and community connected to the work underway. In each update, you can expect to see highlights of completed work, a look ahead at upcoming milestones, photos showcasing progress, and stories of how these new spaces will support student learning and community pride.

To begin, here are several of the first activities now underway:

- Hilltop students and staff had a successful kickoff to the school year, and learning is underway in the Friendship United Methodist Church temporary school site!
- Hilltop Primary School: Interior abatement activities have begun. Construction fencing is scheduled for installation by September 15, with full abatement to follow.
- Hilltop Site Preparation: Construction fencing is being coordinated to ensure safety and define project boundaries.
- Elm Primary School: CTL Engineering is conducting soil borings this week to evaluate site conditions.
- Presbyterian Church of Wyoming (Potential Temporary Site for Elm School): A sewer scope will be initiated soon to assess the feasibility of the facility for temporary instructional space.



This is a moment of growth and possibility for the Wyoming community. These activities represent important first steps in preparing each site for construction, and we will continue to share regular updates as the project advances. Together, we are building spaces that will inspire generations of Cowboys far into the future!
