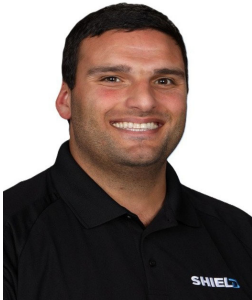
#### **Mo Kesselly**
