

# EMERGENCY TREATMENT & HEALTH HISTORY UPDATE CARD

As we begin the new school year with the implementation of a new computer system, all student health information will be updated and entered based on the content provided on your child's Emergency Treatment & Health History Update Card. This includes:

- Medication Permission: According to Delaware Code 817, **no medication can be given without a parent or guardian's signature.** The medicines that you wish to have available at school must be checked in the box below the demographic information. Nurses will be unable to give any medication without a checked box and a parent or guardian signature.
- All allergies and health concerns must be listed on the Student Health History update. This ensures that nurses have the most accurate health information to provide the best care for your child.
