



**Iberville Parish School Board
Continuous Learning Plan
2025-2026**

Short-term modified operations (1-2 days): A significant portion of the students/staff are not able to be on campus for 1-2 days for face-to face, direct instruction. Continuous learning expectations may be limited or smaller in scope depending on resource availability (e.g. community is without electricity for two (2) days).

Medium-term modified operations: A significant portion of the students/staff are not able to be on campus for 3-10 days for face-to face, direct instruction.

Long-Term Modified Operations: A significant portion of the students/staff are not able to be on campus for more than ten (10) days for face-to face, direct instruction. Operations should have more consistency and expectations of routines and instruction.

Connectivity	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Public libraries and each school site will have WiFi available in designated parking lots. Additional internet points will be added in some of the areas where limited WiFi is available.

<p>Student Responsibilities</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Log on daily as specified in their school schedule. • Cameras will be required to be on for the synchronous portion of the lesson. Students should turn the camera on based on Teacher discretion/classroom activity: Examples (Not limited to)- Testing, Presentations, One-on-one Conferences. Please remember that all lessons will be recorded. • Respond to and engage in daily communication with the virtual teachers • Engage in virtual instruction during designated/scheduled times as communicated by school • Ask clarifying questions when you need help or don't understand • Sign into class ON TIME. You must sign-in within the first 10 minutes of class time and remain the entire duration of class. • Students should be prepared and have all class materials accessible. • All students should be respectful of learning & instruction during class. • Dress appropriately (Shirts and pants must be worn). • Students must be actively engaged and participate in discussions (Google Classroom, Google Meet, Google Doc, etc.). • Students should mute themselves unless requested by the teacher to talk. (Avoid having background noise/inappropriate language during classroom time.)
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	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students should use the raise hand feature to alert the teacher to questions. • Students should use the chat feature only to discuss class related information. • Students must notify the teacher via chat if they must leave a session. (i.e.: restroom break, etc.) • Students should check and submit assignments according to due dates without assistance from outside sources. • If possible, students should have a designated workspace, free of distractions. <p>NOTE: Virtual classes should look and feel like a normal school experience. Our expectations are that all scholars will perform at high standards.</p>
Staff Responsibilities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Office hours will be established by each teacher and communicated in the virtual learning schedule. <p><i>Teachers will be expected to...</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Set up a Google Classroom, invite all students, add principals, and the master teacher as teachers in each of your Google Classrooms. • Create Google Meet links for synchronous learning to occur daily and record lessons. • Use the district-approved high-quality curriculum to plan and facilitate engaging lessons that will create authentic discussions about the learning. • Maintain appropriate pacing (at least 4 lessons per week)

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Incorporate strategies to increase student engagement in a virtual learning environment • Take and report daily attendance for each class. • Contact all students that are absent via telephone, email and document that communication in JCampus. • Check student work and submit at least one grade per week. • Provide meaningful and descriptive feedback during learning sessions and on student assignments (i.e., oral, chatbox, GC comments, email). • Create formative assessments. • ELECTIVE/Enrichment TEACHERS ONLY: Post information (slides, procedures, videos, links) for 4 days of lessons to Google Classroom each week. • ELECTIVE/Enrichment TEACHERS ONLY: Be prepared to provide scheduled lesson/classroom support to Core Teachers
Attendance	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Attendance will be taken during each course and teachers will record this in JCampus. • Students must sign into class ON TIME. Students must sign-in within the first 10 minutes of class time and remain the entire duration of class.
