## COMMUNITY\*

**Brentwood** is a [hamlet](#) in the [Town of Islip](#) in [Suffolk County](#), on [Long Island](#), in [New York](#), United States. The population was 62,387 at the 2020 Census, making it the most populous CDP in Suffolk County and on all of Long Island outside of [New York City](#). The District is composed of eleven elementary schools, four middle schools, a freshman campus, and a high school. The total student enrollment is over 18,056.

## BRENTWOOD HIGH SCHOOL

Brentwood High School is a comprehensive senior high school (Grades 10-12) that is accredited by the New York State Education Department. The 2025-26 total student enrollment is 4,704 of which 1,493 students are seniors.

In 2025, the graduating class consisted of 1,318 students, of which, 82% continued to higher education and 18% selected work, military service or technical instruction.

Brentwood High School is a state-of-the-art facility which offers students a lot of opportunity such as, computer labs, two auditoriums, pool, research laboratories, professional television broadcasting studio, radio station, two libraries, auto repair shop, cosmetology classroom and a wing devoted to the performing and visual arts.

## CURRICULUM

Brentwood High School offers a variety of academic opportunities including: 22 AP classes, an array of Honors- level courses, Regents-level offerings, three second languages, comprehensive art and music programs, television broadcasting program, a full continuum of special education services, and a generous selection of elective courses drawn from all areas including technology, business, family & consumer science, and AFJROTC. ## ADVANCED PLACEMENT RESULTS

- In May 2025, 545 students took AP exams.

- 31 AP Scholars with Honors in 2025

## CLASS RANK

Class rank is based on a quality point system that considers both course grades and course difficulty. Course levels are weighted as follows: Advanced Placement (1.2), Honors (1.1), and Regents (1.0). Rank reflects a student's standing among the entire class, not just college-bound students.

To be ranked, a student must complete at least 15 credits and pass four of the five required Regents exams. All high school and accredited college-level credits earned from 8th grade onward are included if official transcripts are submitted. A student's rank is calculated by dividing total quality points by total credits.

## EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Brentwood High School is proud to offer numerous co-curricular clubs designed to make students' high school years most enjoyable, while promoting a sense of belonging, active leadership, and cultivating friendships.
