



The Penn-Delco School District is located in Southeastern Pennsylvania approximately 15 miles southwest of Philadelphia. The district encompasses Aston Township and the Boroughs of Parkside and Brookhaven in Delaware County. With a district population of 26,000 there is one high school, one middle school, and four elementary schools.

CURRICULUM

Reflecting the district's commitment to meeting the needs of every student, the core courses of language arts, math, science, and social studies are aligned with the Pennsylvania standards. Advanced Placement courses are offered in all core curriculum areas. Technology includes 1:1 laptops for every student and interactive smartboards in classrooms. A wide variety of courses are offered in art, business, family and consumer science, music, STEM/STEAM, and world language.

Programs are available to students who are interested in traditional and non-traditional trade careers through the Delaware County Technical School. These programs are for college bound and career bound students who show an aptitude for a particular area.

Dual Enrollment Programs provide eligible high school students the opportunity to earn college credits while in high school. Offerings include on-site, asynchronous, and college campus opportunities.
