

LOUISIANA'S COURSE CHOICE PROGRAM




Course Choice is a Louisiana program, created through state law, that ensures eligible students have access to the courses they need - even if those courses aren't available at their school. The goal is to make sure every student can take the classes they need to succeed in high school and beyond.

STUDENTS MAY BE ABLE TO TAKE CLASSES SUCH AS:

- ✓ Dual enrollment college classes
- ✓ Career and technical education (CTE) training
- ✓ Classes required for graduation
- ✓ ACT, SAT, or other test prep
- ✓ Courses that support college credit or job certifications
- ✓ Advanced Placement (AP) classes

PARENT NEXT STEPS

Talk with your child about their academic and career goals, and reach out to your school counselor to explore whether Course Choice might be a good fit. Your school will guide the registration process, confirm eligibility, and handle the enrollment in approved courses. However, written parent consent is required, so you'll be involved in any final decisions.
