Honors and Advanced Placement (AP) Courses

A student is eligible to take an AP course if he or she has earned an A in both semesters of a pre-requisite/honors class or bypassed with a B grade. Students are not required to take the AP exam.

Diploma Programs

- † The **AP Capstone** diploma program encourages students to write effectively, think independently, research, collaborate, and learn across disciplines. A student must pass four AP exams in addition to the AP Seminar and AP Research exam to earn this diploma.
- † The **G.E.M.** diploma endorsement is given to students that complete a course sequence focused on preparation for STEM fields, specifically engineering and mining.
- † **Next Reality** diploma endorsement is given to students who complete a course sequence of AP Computer Science Principles and AP Computer Science A to be eligible.

Special Programs

- † The **Campus Ministry** office serves to support the spiritual formation of the community utilizing retreats, education, service, liturgy, prayer, and worship.
- † **Integrated Learning Center (ILC)** provides additional educational and support services to students with diagnosed learning disabilities. Student often complete an Academic Seminar course each year.
- † The **Associated Student Body** is the school's student council. There are typically 15 elected offices, four class representatives for each grade level, and appointed at-large members serving the student body.

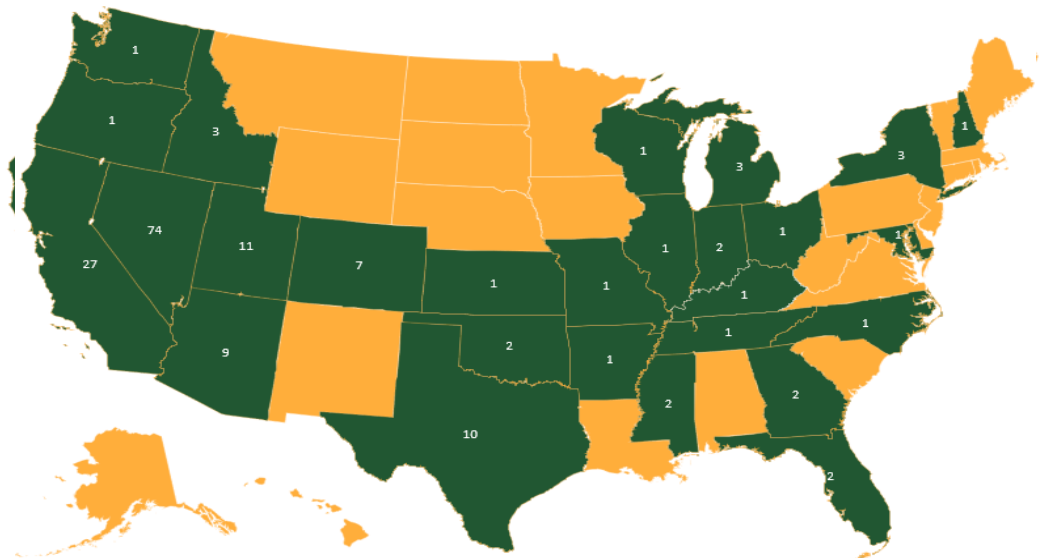
