From 2021- 2026, Clayton County Public Schools and every school will demonstrate eight percentage (8%) points growth each school year for students scoring at the proficient and distinguished levels as evidenced by state, national, and international assessments.

LEE STREET'S INSTRUCTIONAL GOALS:

In alignment with the district's goal, Lee Street Elementary School instructional goals are to increase its Reading and Math scores by eight (8%) percentage points each year as measured by the College and Career Readiness Performance Index (CCRPI). Kindergarten-Second Grade will be measured using data from DIBELS (number of on-level students and/or student growth across the indicators)

-Increase opportunities for daily writing across all content areas.

-Increase usage of mathematical strategies that support GSE math standards each day in classrooms.

-Increase opportunities for daily academic practice to increase phonics, vocabulary development, and comprehension.

TEACHER COMPACT

Lee Street Elementary Teachers will:

-Send home and place assignments in Canvas classroom that increase literacy skills and phonics

-Send home and put practice activities that support the Georgia Frameworks in Canvas.

-Send home and place writing prompts to support writing across all content areas, physically or through in Canvas.

-Send home and place strategies for each math unit that supports the Georgia Frameworks in Canvas.

-Teachers will provide various hands on activities for science that best support the standards

SCHOOL WILL:

-Provide Accelerated Reader Goals to students per grade bands (K-2) and (3-5) to help increase achievement with comprehension, fluency, and vocabulary

-Ensure grade level team planning sessions amongst the teachers are occurring to support high performance while increasing academic discourse and increasing the level of questions that students are asked to promote higher critical thinking.
