Dear AWR and SB Families,

This year, the New Providence School District is working closely with our food service provider, Pomptonian Food Services, to ensure that the snacks and beverages we sell in our elementary cafeterias are aligned with the national Smart Snacks guidelines established by the US Department of Agriculture. As a first step, the NPSD is revising its School Nutrition policy to align with those standards. This is part of our district's effort to promote the health and wellness of our students. In addition to foods on the weekly/daily menus, [here is a list of the snacks and beverages](#) sold each day in our elementary schools, along with the nutritional facts about each item. Here is a more [general price list](#) for all items sold in the elementary cafeterias.

Parents are able to limit or restrict their child's access to any foods, snacks, or beverages by emailing Pomptonian Food Services Director for New Providence, Melissa Muglia, at mmuglia@npsdnj.org. Upon receiving communication, Ms. Muglia will make a note in the student's account so the Pomptonian employee operating the cashier can ensure the limit or restriction is followed. Currently, students at Salt Brook and Allen W. Roberts Elementary Schools are only permitted to purchase a maximum of two snacks per day, and they are prohibited from buying snacks for other students. We ask that parents and guardians review family expectations for buying lunch and/or snacks in the cafeteria and also regularly check their Pay Schools account.
