## 8300 Compulsory age student, not attending, no documentation

**EXCEPTIONS!** Charter, religious and independent schools are not required to report students using the 8300

## If a compulsory age student is expelled or stops attending

1. The charter/religious/ independent school should use the appropriate exit code 3. The district of residence is now responsible for confirming the student is being educated

  should notify the

  residence
- 4. If the district cannot confirm, they must maintain the student enrollment using the 8300

## Who is considered a dropout?

✓ Beyond compulsory age

## **AND**

- ✓ Stop attending prior to:
  - completing graduation requirements
  - Achieving a commencement credential
  - Transferring into an Approved Alternative HS Equivalency Program
    - (AAHSEP)

Students who transfer to an AAHSEP are considered **noncompleters**
