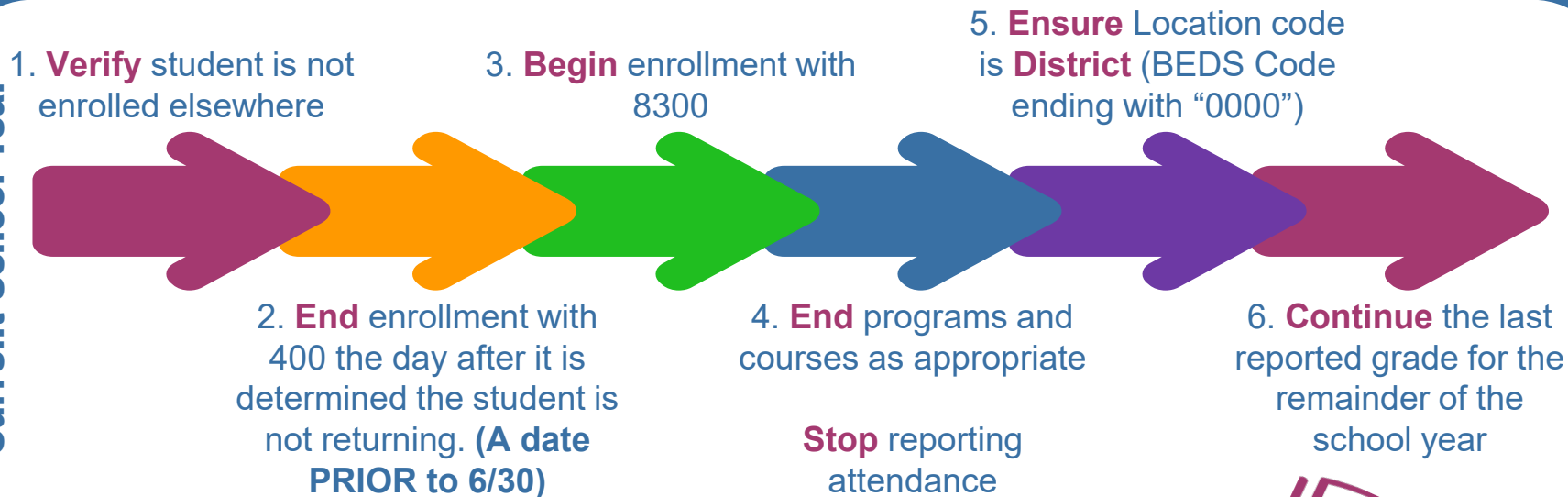

**EXCEPTIONS!** Charter, religious and independent schools are not required to report students using the 8300

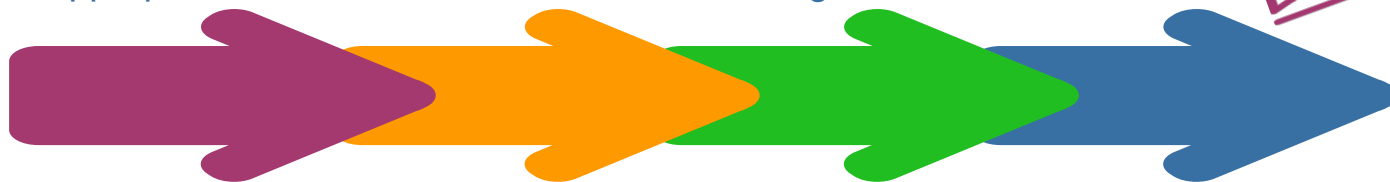
## If a compulsory age student is expelled or stops attending

1. The charter/religious/independent school should use the appropriate exit code

3. The district of residence is now responsible for confirming the student is being educated

2. The charter/religious/independent school should notify the student's district of residence

4. If the district cannot confirm, they must maintain the student enrollment using the 8300



# Who is considered a dropout?

- ✓ Beyond compulsory age  
AND
- ✓ Stop attending prior to:
  - completing graduation requirements
  - Achieving a commencement credential
  - Transferring into an Approved Alternative HS Equivalency Program (AAHSEP)



Students who transfer to an AAHSEP are considered **noncompleters**
