The *J.W. Fanning Institute for Leadership Development at the University of Georgia* is currently accepting nominations for the 2026 Youth LEAD Georgia program. Youth LEAD Georgia is open to students in 10th and 11th grade during the 2025-2026 academic year who

demonstrate leadership potential, academic commitment, and personal motivation.

There is no cost for student participants. Meals, transportation for tours and program activities, and program materials are available through generous donations from Chick-fil-A. Students will be required to arrange transportation to the sessions.

Applicants must be enrolled in a Georgia public high school (including charter schools) for the 2025-2026 school year as a sophomore, junior, or senior. Virtual learning students are still considered enrolled. The Student Advisory Council will meet four times in person during the school year; meeting dates are listed in the application.
