WHAT'S NEW?

As part of its Legislative Meeting on Wednesday, August 27, the Board of Directors approved a resolution identifying the information deliverables required prior to taking action on the proposed Future-Ready Facilities Plan.

The resolution outlined the following:

- Updated District staffing projections to support implementation.
- Timeline that articulates early wins (i.e. benefits in year 0, year 1, etc.) and rationale.
- Financial impact with comprehensive, multi-year projections (including cost of renovations for each building).
- Identified attendance zones and feeder patterns.
- Comprehensive transportation plan (including walkers and bus riders) with rationale.

- Indication of how the plan will improve students' experience.
- Addressing supports for students facing greatest challenges (i.e., African American, Economically Disadvantaged, Special Education, English Language Learners).
- Coordinated engagement, outreach, and communication plan, informed by stakeholder input and community involvement.

No final vote on the permanent closing of any school building shall occur until these deliverables are provided to the Board of Directors and the Board has approved a final plan.

WHAT'S NEXT

Although July 30 marked the conclusion of the Board of Directors' series of Special Public Hearings regarding proposed school-specific closures, PPS remains committed to listening and engaging with families. More than 100 speakers shared their thoughts during the nine hearings held throughout July through in-person testimony, virtual participation, and written submissions.
