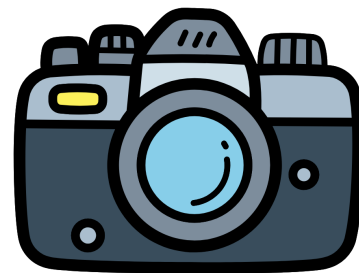

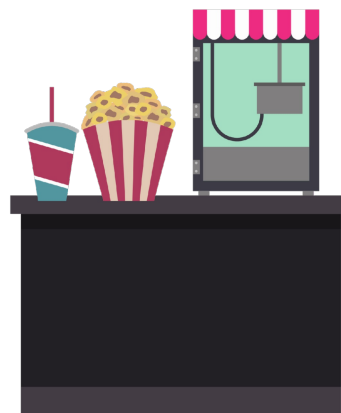

Lower School Families – It's Not Too Late To Order School Supplies!

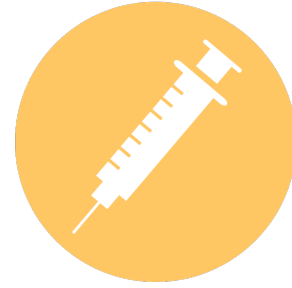

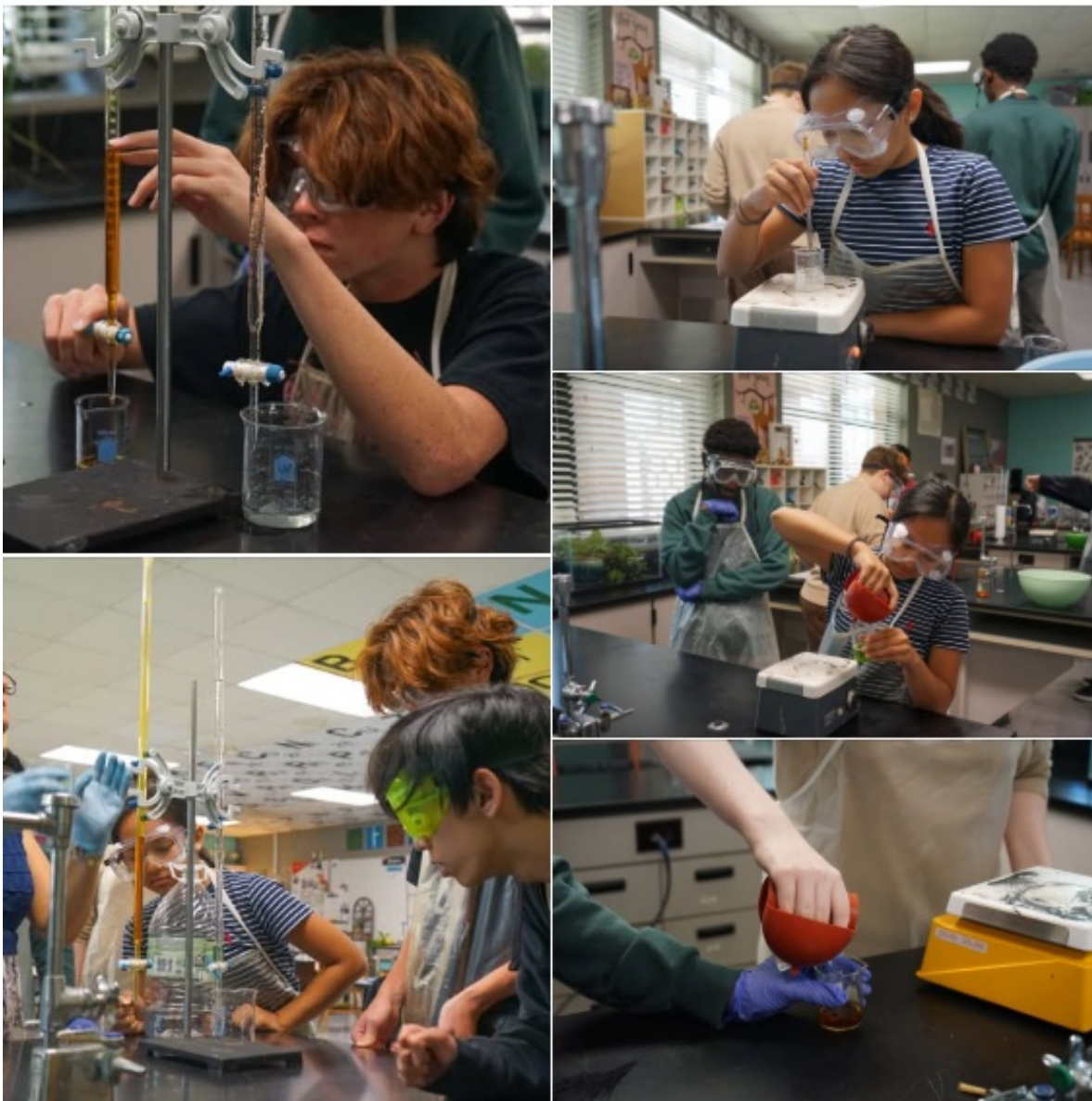
